## **OCTOBER IN THE RECIPE GALLERY: SLOW COOKER HARVEST BEEF STEW**



Fill up the slow cooker with all of the following ingredients, except for the peas and corn.

Stir up the pot and cook slowly for 6 to 8 hours and then stir in the corn and peas just before ladling the stew into bowls to enjoy!!

2 pounds of stewing beef (dried well on paper towels)

2 tablespoons of oil

2 cups of your favourite red wine or water

1 small can of tomato paste

2 onions, chopped

2 carrots, sliced

2 celery ribs, chopped

2 parsnips, sliced

2 potatoes cubed

1 turnip, cubed

3 bay leaves

leaves of a bunch of rosemary, chopped

1 teaspoon of salt and pepper

1 cup of frozen corn and 1 cup of frozen peas

## THE BARN BOARDS


Thanks to the generosity of the Horn Family on Bridge Creek much of Parkside Art Gallery has now been accented with Cariboo history! The barn boards came from one of their ranch's early Cariboo barns. The boards came from trees on the ranch which were logged and then milled by their family.

The reclaimed Grey Barn board that are in Parkside come from the exterior side of the barn siding on a still standing barn in the middle of the ranch. The colors and textures of the boards vary based on the location of the boards. Lighter greys derive from the sunny side of the barn, whereas the shadier sections of the barn tend to have darker grey tones. Reclaimed Brown Barn board is simply the backs of the reclaimed grey board or interior side of the barn. Differences in the shades of greys and browns will vary from barn to barn based on age and use. So next time you are visiting us take a moment to enjoy the boards.

## A LIVING VAN GOGH REPLICA

Stan Herd, a Kansas-based landscape artist, recently completed his very own museum-worthy masterpiece. Only, it can't be moved because it's actually made out of plants growing in a field!

The 1.2-acre crop art 'painting', located on field near Minneapolis, is a replica of Van Gogh's 1889 masterpiece 'Olive Trees'. Herd was commissioned to create it by the Minneapolis Institute of Art, where the Van Gogh original currently hangs. It took him six long months of digging, planting, and mowing a giant grass field before the 'earthwork' was finally complete on September 11. It is best viewed from high above, especially if you happen to be flying in to the Minneapolis-St. Paul International Airport.



"When you're on ground level you can't tell what the cuts even look like, but when you get up there you can see the patterns," said Rick King, board member of the Minneapolis Museum and the Metropolitan Airports Commission. "If you are landing from the southeast and flying northwest, it will be on your left-hand side as you approach the airport."
